Know your limits and stay within your ability level

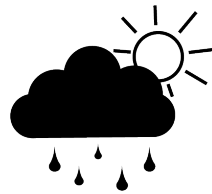
PLAN AHEAD

Check the weather forecast and adjust your plans and gear to suit

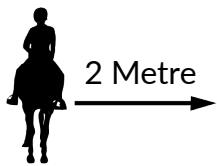


Avoid hotspots and choose quieter routes and times

LEAVE SPACE



Be friendly and courteous to everyone you meet



Keep at least 2 m from other people and pass anyone you meet at a walk



Leave space for other car park users



Respect peoples' privacy, especially passing houses

LEAVE NO TRACE



Don't damage paths



Clear dung from parking areas



Take your litter home



Move your horse off paths to dung, or dismount and kick dung to the side
