

Scottish Natural Heritage on behalf of the Upland Path Advisory Group (UPAG) have recently updated the 'Upland Path Management' manual.

The new 2nd edition online manual covers the process of managing an upland path project through the different stages. There is detailed information on project planning, upland path surveys, project delivery and contract management, managing health and safety, and training and developing the project team. In this new edition there are additional chapters on considering whether path work is the most sustainable solution, and consents and planning that could effect a project.
